

Part-Time Music Ministry Paid Internship Position Available

This will begin as a 7-month position with the opportunity to expand into a permanent position. Tentative start date: September 1, 2020.

General Job Description: Utilize musical talents as well as a passion for music ministry to plan and lead worship services and other special events on a part-time basis for a small rural church.

Qualifications:

- Have a personal calling to explore the music ministry.
- Be able to lead worship using both instrument (guitar, piano, etc.) and vocal.
- Have a team spirit and be willing to use existing repertoire of music while working with other musicians to continue to expand music selections.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

The intern will be responsible for the following:

- Two Sundays each month, the intern will work with the pastor and/or current worship leader to identify musical selections that align with scripture/sermon focus, and he/she will work with existing Praise team members to lead the music during service.
 - Music will be selected and distributed to other team members at least one week prior to worship (4 hours per month).
 - Intern will practice with the Praise Team Thursday evenings beginning at 6:30 p.m. for the weeks they are leading the music ministry (2 hours per month).
 - On Sunday, the intern will practice with the Praise team at 9:20 a.m. and then be available to lead worship from 10:50 a.m. to approximately 12:00 p.m. (6 hours per month).
- Working with the pastor, the intern will further explore his/her calling to the music ministry while planning and leading special events each month (approximately 7 hours per month).
